- The meeting will be held under the International UEM Sporting Code, the CCR rules, the general competition rules of the SML when applicable, and these Supplementary regulations which have been duly examined and approved by the SML.

4. Entries

- Entry form approved by the FMN of the participants must be sent to Finnish Drag Bike Association not later than one month before the event.
- Entry fee €260 must be paid to FHRA account number: 549705-28011, Okobank Helsinki, Finland, IBAN FI59 5497 0520 0080 11, swift OKOY FI HH.
- Late entry fee, if entry accepted, will be €520,-
- Entry will include 10 team passes per entrant.
- To be eligible for any awards in the UEM European Drag Bike Championships UEM European Drag Bike Championship series registration fee has to be paid by each rider to the Championship administration at the latest 30 days before taking part in any Championship round. This fee is in the sum of €600 and covers all rounds of the Championship. This registration fee is in addition to all normal race entry fees.

5. Technical Control and Verification

6. Practice

- Thursday 10.00 – 18.00 Friday 10.00 – 18.00 and Saturday 10.00 – 18.00.
FIA&UEM rounds starts on Friday at 12.00 and 16.00, on Saturday at 11.00, 14.00 and 17.00.

7. Schedule of Races

- First elimination round Sunday 8 July 2007 at 11.00.
- All motorcycles must be in the Line Up before the start, 15 minutes before each race.

8. Pits

- Silence in the pits between 20.00 – 08.00, on Sunday till 09.00.
- When the bike is staying at the pits, there must be a carpet, plate or similar under the engine and the transmission in case there is an oil leak. Every team must have at least 6kg fire extinguisher and a fire blanket at the pit with easy access. Smoking in the pits prohibited except in the areas provided for smokers. All fire work (welding, grinding etc.) is allowed only by the permission of the Clerk of the Course / Race Director.

9. Insurance

- By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the driver certifies that the driver or passenger is insured in accordance with the UEM requirements.
- Third party insurance in respect of drivers and passengers covering accidents occurring during the meeting including practicing will be at the responsibility of the organizer in accordance with the UEM Sporting Code.
- The organizer disclaims all responsibility for damage of a motorcycle, its accessories and components arising out of an accident, fire or other case.

10. Protests and Appeals



- Any person or group of persons – driver, passenger, entrant, manufacturer, official etc. - recognised by the UEM and concerned by a decision taken under authority of the UEM, may ask for redress for the consequences of that decision.
- Generally, protests against the eligibility of a driver, passenger, entrant or a motorcycle entered must be made before the start of the official practice.
- Protest against results must be presented to the International Jury within 30 minutes following the announcement of the results.
- An appeal may be made against decision of the International Jury to the International Disciplinary Court (CDI).
- All protests to the International Jury must be made in accordance with the requirement of the Disciplinary and Arbitration Code of the UEM and be accompanied by a fee of €130,- returnable if the protest is justified.

11. Prizes

Prizes will be paid as follows per class. They are payable in Euros.

Pro Stock Bike:

Each qualified rider	€460,-
Each round win	€270,-

Top Fuel Bike:

Each qualified rider	€460,-
Each round win	€350,-

Super Twin Top Fuel:

Each qualified rider	€460,-
Each round win	€350,-

The Organiser will pay all additional minimum of €320 in travel compensation for foreigner competitors (riders who do not hold a licence in event host country) who have qualified within the top eight for that class.

To be eligible for prize money or travel Expenses, each rider must pay a championship registration entry fee, of €600. The fee should be paid to the promoter/championship administrator 30 days before the first race.

12. Prize Giving Ceremony

- Date: 08 July 2007
- Place: Alastaro Circuit
- Time: immediately after the race when the protest time closes
